This platform aims to empower and somewhat prepare these young girls for the critical phase of puberty and adolescence, build their self-esteem, encourage them to dream and dream big and work hard towards achieving their dreams. We bring different speakers, take the Girls on excursions - we had the privilege of Miss Lira work-shopping the Girls in 2014. Our priority goal is to support them to complete high school without unplanned pregnancy, strife to acquire tertiary education and recognise their live's purpose and end the cycle of poverty.

Human Rights Day: Annual Leaders event Against Abuse: The event aims to target Leaders in all sectors of our economy and society in our attempt increase awareness and engagement with the abuse which takes place in all spaces at all times...especially now that we are exposed to more gruesome, violent and fatal abuse of the vulnerable. • AUGUST:

Womens Day: Bikers Ride Against Abuse of Women (BRAAW): Hosted on South Africa's Women's day to create noise and awareness against women abuse and just as the Women of 1956 marched to the Union Buildings, the Bikers and Riders will be on our streets to call for an end to abuse of women and children. This is because we cannot celebrate Women's day when more and more women are yet to be emancipated. The BRAAW is an opportunity for all South Africans to participate in action against abuse of the women on this special day.

Beaded White Ribbon: Though the campaign continues throughout the year, we intensify effort during Women's Month. It is the voice for the victims, survivors and sufferers and increases awareness of our stance against abuse. It is dedicated to remind society of the cries, screams, rage and deaths resulting from violence and abuse against the vulnerable - it speaks against abuse when we are busy with other life's demands.

Through the Beaded White Ribbon the message against abuse will reach the workplace, the boardrooms, churches, buses, trains and most importantly our homes - open dialogue where it is needed the most. The perpetrator too will become conscious of the war against abuse and in this way behaviour will start to be influenced. It is also a source

if income for the unemployed women that make the Beaded Ribbons.

• DECEMBER:

Girls of Hope Camp: The planned camp will intensify our effort to empower and inspire the Girls towards a brighter future, encourage them to stay in school and to follow and work hard towards realising their dreams and ambitions, build their self-esteem and also help them overcome their respective life challenges and traumatic experiences. The camp will also be a celebration of the year's work, commitment and achievements.
